

Antonov An-14A

for MS Flight Simulator 2004.

Important Information.

Please, read the following carefully!

First of all let us thank you for downloading this archive! It contains a complete simulation of Antonov An-14A Aircraft designed specially for MS Flight Simulator 2004 (aka FS9.0, aka The Century of Flight).

After the installation the model is placed into the Aircraft's An-14 subfolder. All xml gauges are located in the single cab-file in the aircraft's Panel subfolder. C-gauges (*.gau) files go to main FS Gauges folder. The aircraft will display during selection as Antonov -> An-14. There is also a default flight for the aircraft with "cold and dark" cockpit named An-14 Default Flight - the model is placed in the KOLM airfield (Olympia) just a few miles off MS-default Seattle. After loading FS - go to "Select Flight" screen, scroll the list of "Choose a category" and select An-14 Default Flight.
