Scenery includes Kumbor seaplane base and some ships and objects in Cattaro harbor, Teodo harbor and in more distant regions of Adriatic sea as it was during the First World war 1914 – 1918 years. All geographic names are named as it was during 1914 – 1918 years.

Installation. As usual. Copy files from “EFFECTS” folder in archive to “EFFECTS” folder of MSFS to have all smokes, wakes and sprays working.

Compatibility. The scenery was made to work with default mesh. Compatible with FS2004 Balkans 2004 SRTM Mesh Scenery, v1.0. by Pietro Mauri.

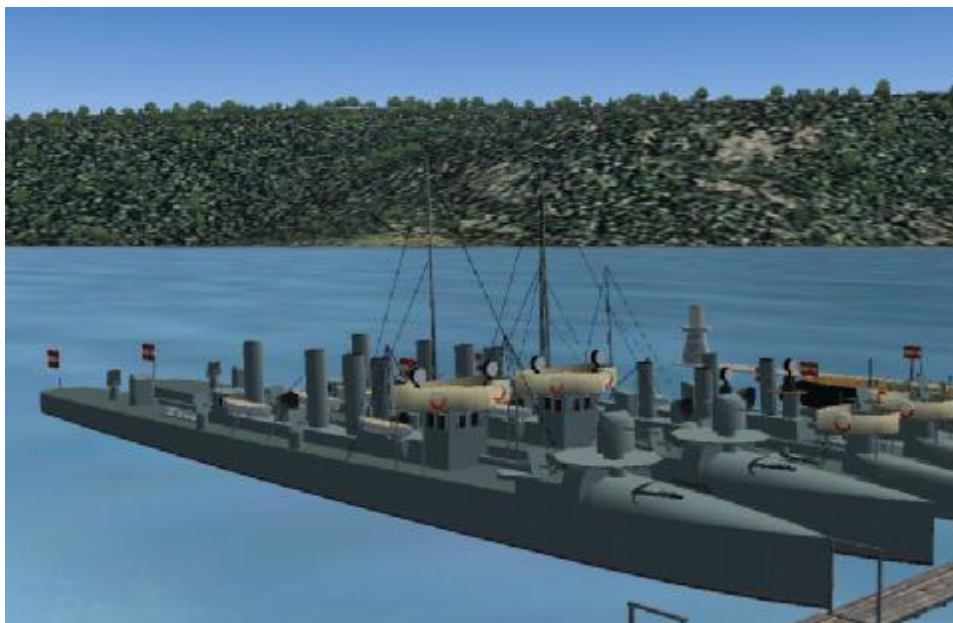

Submarine and torpedo boat base Djenovic is located to the south-east side of the seaplane station. Two submarines of S.M.U.-5 type, destroyers of “Huszar” class and torpedo boats of “Tb-I” class are at pier.

Battleships of the 2-nd division of the 1-st battleship brigade are staying on anchors in Teodo bay. These battleships are of “Radetzky” class. They played significant role in the defence of Cattaro in 1914. Light cruiser “Admiral Spaun” and torpedo depot ship “Gaa” are located to the south and to the east from seaplane station.

Another light cruiser, protected cruisers “Kaiser Franz Josef I” and torpedo cruiser “Panter” are located in Cattaro harbor.

Other scenery objects, without menu entry records



Four French submarines are placed in positions in Adriatic sea. All submarines are under submerged periscope during day and surfaces at dusk and night. One can call submarine at surface by setting COM1 to 118.0. Exact submarine positions are:

1. At the entrance into Cattaro bay, at N42° 20.4' E18° 32.8'
2. To the east off Antivari, at N42° 04.7' E19° 29.1'
3. Off Spalato harbor, at N43° 23.2' E16° 09.3'
4. To the west of Sebenico harbor entrance, at N43° 38.3' E15° 49.6'

Pelagosa island is located at N42° 23.5' E16° 15.6'. There is a lighthouse on the island. Austrian submarine and Italian scouting vessel are located nearby.

Ships, blocking Antivari port are located at N41° 57.06' E019° 06.15'. This group consists of protected cruiser “Zenta” and destroyer “Ulan”.
